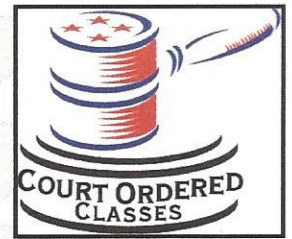

To whom it may concern,

As requested via our phone conversation, I inform you that Court Ordered Classes' Domestic Violence/Batterers Intervention program consists of 52 weeks group sessions provided by:

1. Inessa Nazaryan - male and female group facilitator, case manager, program director
2. Edward Abasta - male group facilitator, case manager
3. Janet Bennet - back up group facilitator

Prior to start the participation in Court Ordered Classes' Domestic Violence/Batterers Intervention program, potential clients undergo an intake assessment consisting of socioeconomic situation, education, family background and history, medical and other treatment history, prior instances of violence, lethality related questionnaire as well as criminal history, relationship history and group rules.

Our program curriculum is based on the training recommendations for facilitators of Los Angeles Domestic Violence/ Batterers Intervention programs with the following objectives:

Definitions of physical, economic, emotional, sexual and verbal abuse. Teaching techniques for stopping abuse, how to take "Time Out", how to develop equality, respect and accountability in the relationship. Examining the cultural and social contexts, increase the participants understanding and willingness to change by exploring actions, intents and beliefs that support quality in the relationship. In order to achieve the above objectives, the curriculum is organized around the themes found on the Equality Wheel and its corresponding Power and Control Wheel: Nonviolence; Nonthreatening Behavior; Respect; Trust and Support; Honesty and Accountability; Responsible Parenting; Shares Responsibilities; Economic Partnership; Sexual Respect; and Negotiation and Fairness vs. Power and Control, which includes following: physical and sexual abuse, using economic abuse, using coercion and threats, using intimidation, using emotional abuse, using isolation, minimizing and denying and blaming, using children, using male privilege.

Court Ordered Classes' Domestic Violence/Batterers Intervention groups are provided in English at 25350 Magic Mountain Parkway, Suite 300 in the City of Valencia, CA 91355. We are prepared to provide our program in Spanish, Russian and Armenian languages as well.

Our program rules and regulations are based on State of California penal code 1203.097 regarding domestic violence/batterer intervention programs.
